HOW TO GET THE COASTREK ROUTE ON YOUR PHONE

STEP 1

- On your smartphone download



iPhone: Download via the App Store

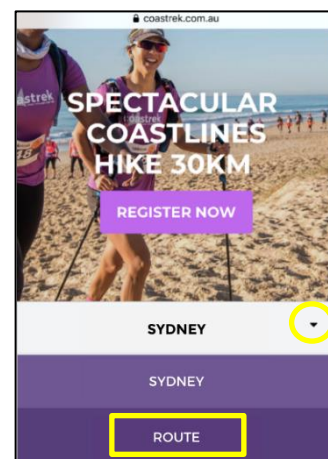
Android: Get it on Google Play / Play Store



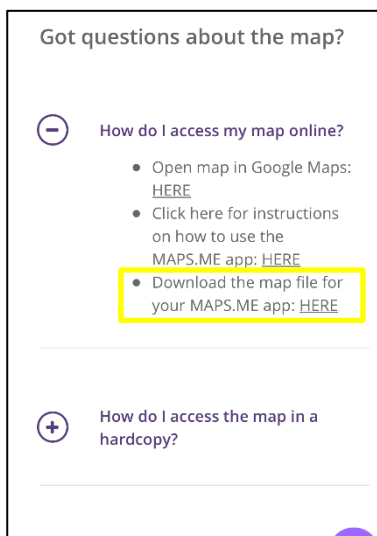
STEP 2

FOR AN IPHONE

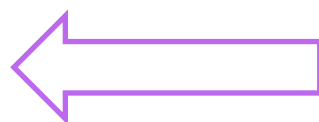
- Open your web browser and go to the Sydney event page
- Then open the Route page by clicking the down arrow next to 'Sydney' and follow these steps:



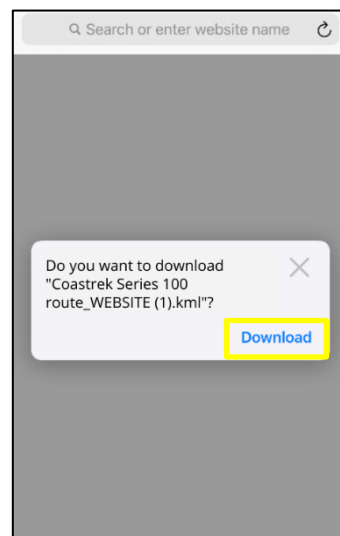
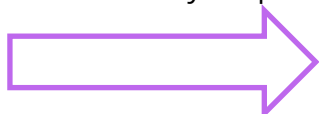
STEP 3



Select the highlighted option to open the download page

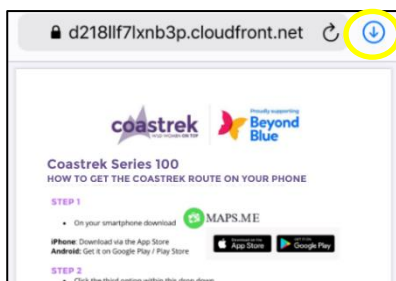


Select 'Download' to prompt the route file to download to your phone

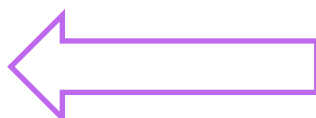


If you are having difficulty downloading the file, try repeating the following steps in a different browser i.e. Safari, Google Chrome or Firefox.

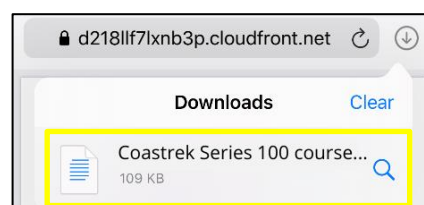
STEP 4



Select the arrow pointing down in the top right-hand corner of your screen to open your downloads



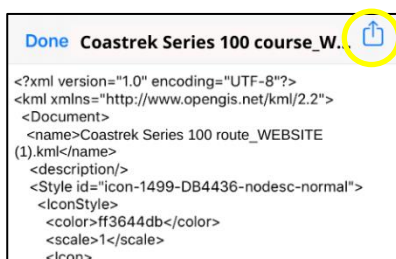
Select 'Coastrek Series 100 route'



For some devices this is the final step.

Continue to follow the below steps if the file doesn't automatically download.

STEP 5

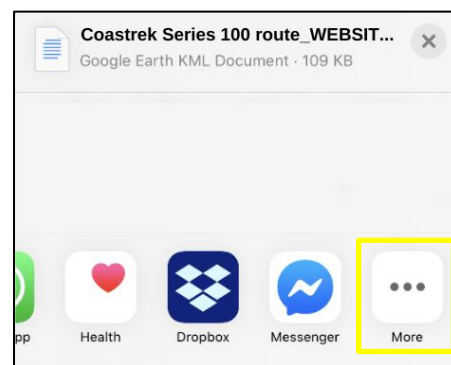
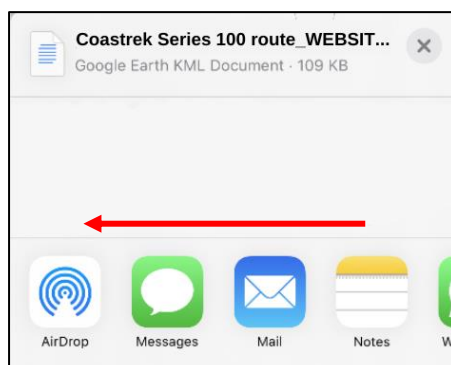
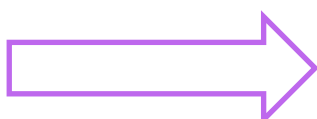


After selecting the route, a source code page will automatically open

Select the box with the arrow facing up to prompt these options to open

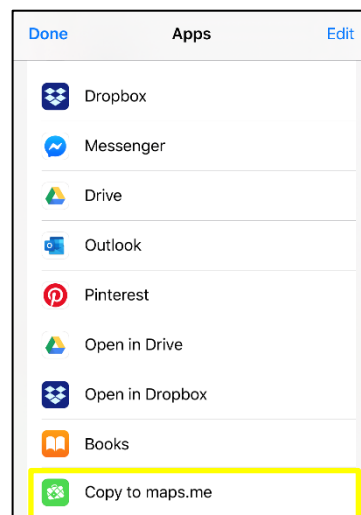
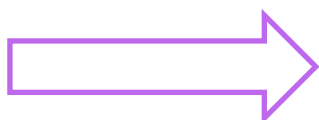


Slide the apps across until you see the 'More' icon



STEP 6

- This will open a list of Apps – scroll down until you see ‘Copy to maps.me’
- Select this option, the download will open in MAPS.ME and commence loading the route to your Bookmarks

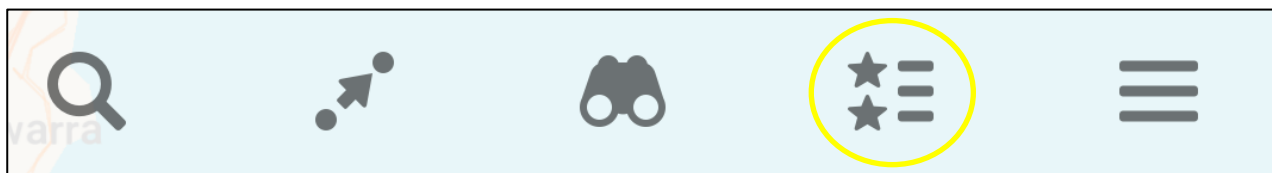


FOR AN ANDROID

- Once downloaded from The Route page, go to your ‘My Files’ folder and select ‘Download’
- You should see the .KML file here.
- Click on the file and it will automatically load within MAPS.ME. If it doesn’t, open the MAPS.ME app and find the file in Bookmarks – select it to start the download

USING THE ROUTE

- In the MAPS.ME app select this icon from the bottom of the screen:



- Ensure there is a blue tick next to the “Coastrek Series 100 route...”
- Then click the arrow at the top left-hand side of your screen to return to the map view
- **Make sure you have the NSW map downloaded also**
- Your location is indicated with a blue arrow  You must have Location Services activated, so the route can locate you

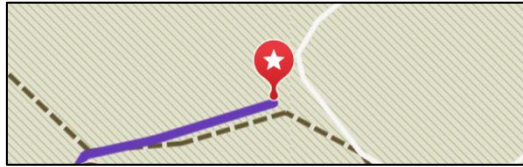
NOTE

- The Route line does not always match up exactly with the base map
- Follow the pink reflective route markers and the orange arrows to keep on track




KEY MARKERS

- Look out for these markers on the route as they pinpoint track information like Luv Stops, toilets, water refill and km distance markers



- Each of the markers will look the same so 'tap' them on the route and their information will be displayed

TO IDENTIFY KEY MARKERS MORE EASILY

- A good trick to identify markers easier while trekking is to change the colour of specific ones you think you might need on the day
- Tap on your favourite markers and then 'swipe up' to view the description
- Select [Edit Bookmark](#) and then  Red to edit the colour
- Choose a new colour that you will recognise on the route

TO SAVE ON BATTERY LIFE

- Turn your phone on to **Flight Mode** but leave **Location Services on!**

OR

- Use the app at intervals and turn off in between
