1		7	35km Start - Yallingup Beach. Woohoo!
2	0.976	<b>→</b>	After 1km, turn right off the beach onto the access track. This is a single file track.
3	1.138	Ľ	Turn left to follow the Cape to Cape Track
4	5.415	K	Keep left onto Cape to Cape Track
5	7.005		Follow the track onto Kabbijgup Beach
6	7.039		Follow the beach for approx. 450m, then follow the trail back up to the Cape to Cape Track.
7	7.499		Turn sharp right up to the Three Bears carpark
8	7.540	•	You've reach the Three Bears water stop! Quick stop for those who need a water refill or a loo visit. First aid is also positioned here in case you need them. You're at the 7.5km mark
9	7.581	<b>→</b>	Head back down the stairs to continue on the Cape to Cape track
10	9.240		Continue straight on the Cape to Cape Track
11	9.957	K	Turn slight left onto Cape to Cape Track
12	10.205	K	Turn sharp left towards Sugarloaf Rock carpark
13	10.341	•	You've reached the Kiss Stop at Sugarloaf Rock! Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet! You're at the 10.5km mark
14	10.355		Depart the Kiss Stop & head back up the pathway past the toilet block
15	10.487		Continue straight along the Cape to Cape Track
16	10.636	<b>→</b>	Carefully cross Sugarloaf Road & continue on the Cape to Cape Track
17	12.312	<b>→</b>	Turn right onto Cape to Cape Track
18	13.494	K	Cross over the dirt road & continue on the track up to Cape Naturaliste Lighthouse
19	13.812		Turn left through the small gate at the Cape Naturaliste Visitor centre
20	13.866	7	You have reached the Cape Naturaliste Luv Stop! Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet! There is 20km to go
21	13.883	A	Head theough the arch and turn right towards the toilets
22	13.914	7	At the carpark turn right to stay on the footpath
23	13.951	7	Continue straight past the small gate to rejoin the Cape To Cape Track (same Track you came in on)
24	14.077	K	Turn slight left onto Cape to Cape Track
25	14.252	<b>→</b>	Turn right onto the dirt road
