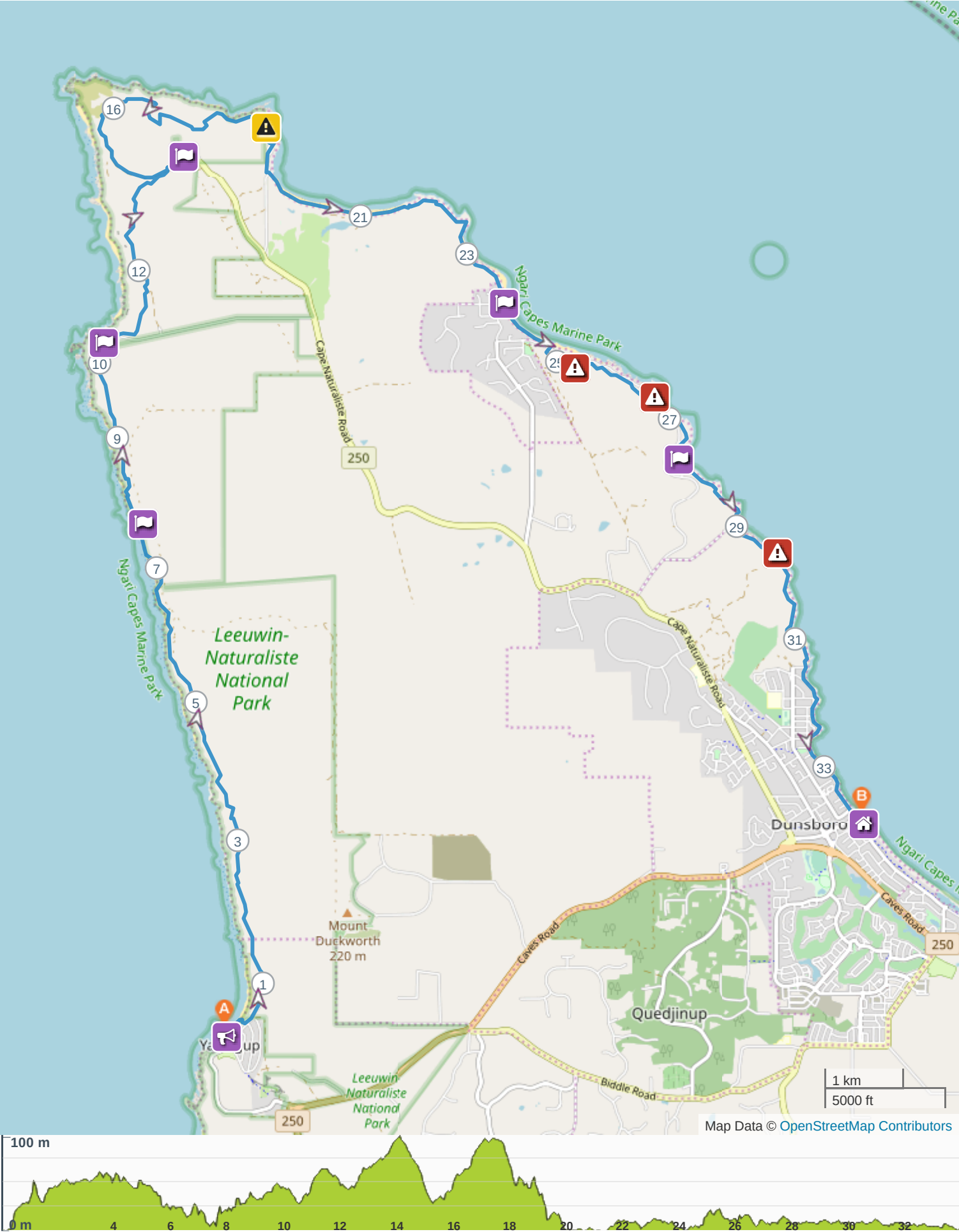


Coastrek Margaret River 2026 - 35km Event



ROUTE DIRECTIONS

No	Km	Turn	Directions
1	0.000	↗	 35km Start - Yallingup Beach. Woohoo!
2	0.290	➔	Turn right off the beach towards the carpark
3	0.384	↶	Turn left onto Dawson Drive
4	0.731	↶	Turn left
5	0.734	➔	Continue onto Cape to Cape Track
6	7.134		Follow the track onto Kabbijgup Beach
7	7.168		Follow the beach for approx. 450m, then follow the trail back up to the Cape to Cape Track.
8	7.629		Turn sharp right up to the Three Bears carpark
9	7.669	↓	 You've reached the Three Bears water stop! Quick stop for those who need a water refill or a loo visit. You're at the +/-7.5km mark
10	7.710	➔	Head back down the stairs to continue on the Cape to Cape track
11	9.370		Continue straight on the Cape to Cape Track
12	10.087	↶	Turn slight left onto Cape to Cape Track
13	10.335	↶	Turn sharp left towards Sugarloaf Rock carpark
14	10.470	↓	 You've reached the Kiss Stop at Sugarloaf Rock! Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet! You're at the 10.5km mark
15	10.484		Depart the Kiss Stop & head back up the pathway past the toilet block
16	10.616		Continue straight along the Cape to Cape Track
17	10.765	➔	Carefully cross Sugarloaf Road & continue on the Cape to Cape Track
18	13.624	↶	Cross over the dirt road & continue on the track up to Cape Naturaliste Lighthouse
19	13.941		Turn left through the small gate at the Cape Naturaliste Visitor centre
20	13.995	↗	 You have reached the Cape Naturaliste Luv Stop! Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet! 20km to go!
21	14.012	↘	Head through the arch and turn right towards the carpark
22	14.043	↗	At the carpark turn right to stay on the footpath
23	14.080	↗	Continue straight past the small gate to rejoin the Cape To Cape Track (same Track you came in on)
24	14.206	↶	Turn slight left onto Cape to Cape Track
25	14.381	➔	Turn right onto the dirt road
26	15.208	↗	Continue straight on the dirt road
27	15.609	↗	Keep right to continue on the dirt road

28	15.778	↙	Turn sharp left onto the Cape Naturaliste Track
29	15.828	➔	Turn right onto the Cape Naturaliste Track
30	16.606	➔	Keep right on the Track
31	16.839	↖	Keep left on the track
32	17.008	↩	Turn left on the track
33	17.616	↖	Turn left onto Bunker Bay Loop Trail
34	18.798	↙	Turn left on the track
35	18.927		 Use caution: this section is short but steep and the rocks are very pointy! Take your time
36	19.276	↘	Turn right towards Bunker Bay carpark
37	19.374		Carefully wander through Bunker Bay carpark, keeping to the left
38	19.530	↖	Turn slight left onto Bunker Bay Road, keeping to the left
39	19.672	↖	Turn left towards Bunker Bay beach
40	19.784		Hit the sand for approx. 2km
41	21.606	↖	Exit the beach towards Rocky point. Yes some rock hopping!
42	21.819	↖	Keep left to stay on the rocks, This section of the trail can be tricky to find the path. Keep an eye out for the marker posts & arrows and use caution when crossing the granite rocks as they can be slippery when wet. Go slow
43	22.629		Exit the rock section and rejoin the track towards Eagle Bay
44	23.355		Continue straight
45	23.854	↩	 You've reached the Eagle Bay Luv Stop. Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet. +/- 10km to go!
46	23.884	↗	Exit the Luv Stop towards Eagle Bay beach
47	23.891	➔	Turn right to enjoy your walk along the beach for around 1km.
48	24.729	➔	Turn right exiting the beach at the Baudin Memorial towards Eagle Bay - Meelup Rd
49	24.777		Carefully cross Eagle Bay-Meelup Rd & head into the Meelup Regional Park
50	24.848	↩	Turn left & follow the trail
51	25.261	↗	 Dieback boot cleaning station. You must clean your footwear to remove any soil which may contain dieback spores to reduce the risk of spreading Phytophthora cinnamomic

53	26.583		Turn right and carefully cross Eagle Bay - Meelup Rd
54	26.620	↘	Walk through the Point Piquet carpark, then turn right & follow the trail for about 1km towards Meelup Beach

55	27.693		 You have reached the Meelup Kiss Stop! Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet! +/- 6km to go
56	27.774		Depart the Kiss Stop continuing through the carpark and onto the Meelup-Dunsborough trail
57	29.011		Continue straight onto the path, through Castle Rock carpark
58	29.657		Keep left on the Meelup-Dunsborough Trail
59	29.674	↗	 Dieback boot cleaning station. You must clean your footwear to remove any soil which may contain dieback spores to reduce the risk of spreading Phytophthora cinnamomic
60	31.459	↗	Exit the trail at Hurford Street, head straight ahead towards Bay View Crescent
61	32.015		Continue on the trail past the Dunsborough Boat Ramp, then playground
62	32.438	↖	Keep left on Beach rd
63	33.925		 Finish at Centennial Park, Dunsborough - Woohoo! You did it!
