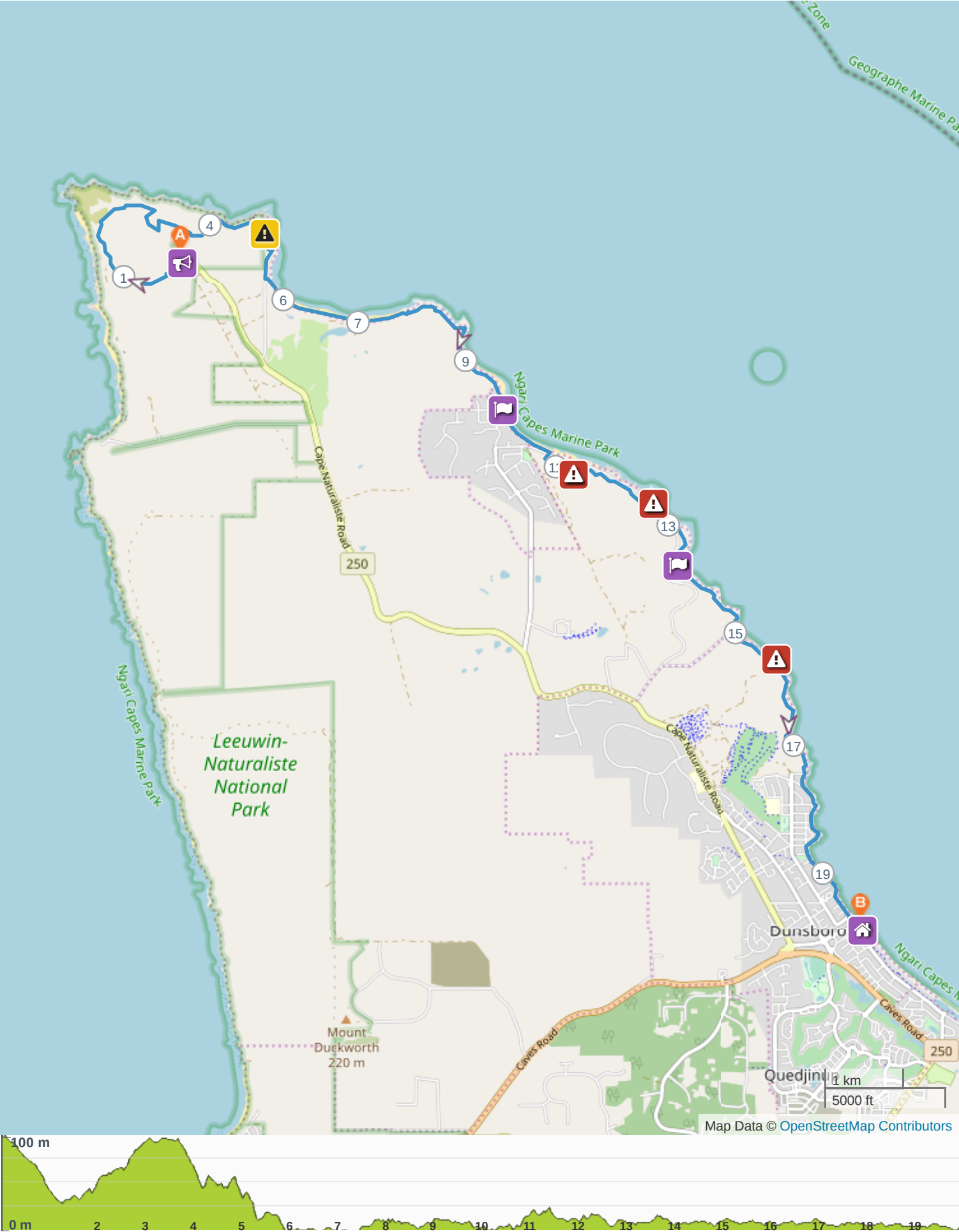


Coastrek Margaret River 2026 - 20km Event



ROUTE DIRECTIONS

No	Km	Turn	Directions
1	0.000		 20km Start - Cape Naturaliste Lighthouse - Woohoo!
2	0.020	↘	Head through the arch and turn right towards the carpark
3	0.054	➔	At the carpark turn right to stay on the footpath
4	0.213	↙	Turn slight left onto Cape to Cape Track
5	0.387	➔	Turn right onto the dirt road
6	1.207	↗	Continue straight on the dirt road
7	1.215	↗	Continue straight on the dirt road
8	1.615	↗	Keep right to continue on the dirt road
9	1.785	↙	Turn sharp left onto the Cape Naturaliste Track
10	1.834	➔	Turn right onto the Cape Naturaliste Track
11	2.613	➔	Keep right on the Track
12	2.845	↙	Keep left on the track
13	3.014	↩	Turn left on the track
14	3.623	↙	Turn left onto Bunker Bay Loop Trail
15	4.805	↙	Turn left on the track
16	4.933		 Use caution: this section is short but steep and the rocks are very pointy! Take your time
17	5.282	↘	Turn right towards Bunker Bay carpark
18	5.381		Carefully wander through Bunker Bay carpark, keeping to the left
19	5.536	↙	Turn slight left onto Bunker Bay Road, keeping to the left
20	5.679	↙	Turn left towards Bunker Bay beach
21	5.790		Hit the sand for approx. 2km
22	7.613	↙	Exit the beach towards Rocky point. Yes some rock hopping!
23	7.826	↙	Keep left to stay on the rocks, This section of the trail can be tricky to find the path. Keep an eye out for the marker posts & arrows and use caution when crossing the granite rocks as they can be slippery when wet. Go slow
24	8.635		Exit the rock section and rejoin the track towards Eagle Bay
25	9.364		Continue straight
26	9.862	↙	 You've reached the Eagle Bay Luv Stop. Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet. +/- 10km to go!
27	9.891	↗	Exit the Luv Stop towards Eagle Bay beach
28	9.907	↗	Turn right and enjoy your walk along the beach for around 1km
29	10.731	➔	Turn right exiting the beach at the Baudin Memorial towards Eagle Bay - Meelup Rd

30	10.778		Carefully cross Eagle Bay-Meelup Rd & head into the Meelup Regional Park
31	10.849	←	Turn left & follow the trail
32	11.262	↗	 Dieback boot cleaning station. You must clean your footwear to remove any soil which may contain dieback spores to reduce the risk of spreading Phytophthora cinnamomic
33	12.505		 Dieback boot cleaning station. You must clean your footwear to remove any soil which may contain dieback spores to reduce the risk of spreading Phytophthora cinnamomic
34	12.584		Turn right and carefully cross Eagle Bay - Meelup Rd
35	12.621	↘	Walk through the Point Piquet carpark, then turn right & follow the trail for about 1km towards Meelup Beach
36	13.694		 You have reached the Meelup Kiss Stop! Take a break, grab a snack, drink some water and rest those feet! +/- 6km to go
37	13.775		Depart the Kiss Stop continuing through the carpark and onto the Meelup-Dunsborough trail
38	15.012		Continue straight onto the path, through Castle Rock carpark
39	15.659		Keep left on the Meelup-Dunsborough Trail
40	15.676	↗	 Dieback boot cleaning station. You must clean your footwear to remove any soil which may contain dieback spores to reduce the risk of spreading Phytophthora cinnamomic
41	17.460	↗	Exit the trail at Hurford Street, head straight ahead towards Bay View Crescent
42	18.016		Continue on the trail past the Dunsborough Boat Ramp, then playground
43	18.439	↖	Keep left on Beach rd
44	19.926		 Finish at Centennial Park, Dunsborough - Woohoo! You did it!
